C., according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to me the said mortgagor—in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents (receipt of which is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, Greer, S. C., its successors and assigns:

That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, about one mile southwest from the City of Greer, S. C., lying on the northeast side of a new road, and being a part of the same tract of land that was conveyed to me by deed from the E. C. Bailey Estate, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning on a point in the center of the said new road (iron pin under fill in road), joint corner of the one half acre being conveyed to me this day by deed from I. B. Dobson and R. A. Dobson Estate, and runs thence with the center of the said new road, S. 40-00 E. 215.6 feet to a point in the said road; thence N. 50-00 E. 18 feet to a stake or iron pin on the bank of the said road, then continueing with the same course for a total distance of 208.6 feet to a stake or iron pin; thence N. 40-00 W. 182.9 feet to a stake or iron pin about 15 feet south from a small branch; thence S. 70-30-W. 93.5 feet to a stake or iron pin on the southern edge of the said small branch; thence crossing the said branch S. 50-00 W. 121 feet to the beginning corner, containing one (1) acre, more or less.
