 - the All payments mentioned in the preceding subsection of this paragraph and all payments to be much made the note secured hereby shall be added together, and the aggregate amount thereof shall be paid by the Northagor each month in a single payment to be applied by the Mortgagee to the following items in the order of torth;
 - taxes, special assessments, fire and other hazard insurance premiums; (!)
 - interest on the note secured hereby; and (II)

If there shall be a default mader any of the provisions of this mortgage resulting in a public sale of the premises covered hereby, or if the property is otherwise acquired after default, the Mortgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the balance then remaining in the funds accumulated under (a) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal then remaining unpaid under the note secured hereby.

The Mortgagor further agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within 60 days from the date hereof (written statement of any officer of the Department of Housing and Urban Development or authorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the said time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this marty are, being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility), the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable. This option may not be exercised by the Mortgapee when the incligibility for insurance under the National Housing Act is due to the Mortgagee's failure to remit the mortgage insuranpremium to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
