NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of

Greenville, being shown and designated as Lot 20 on plat of Woodside Mills, Simpsonville, which plat is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 5, and having such courses and distances as will appear by reference to said plat.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagor herein by Woodside Mills which deed is recorded in Deed Book 475, at page 493, on April 3, 1953. This conveyance was also to Hobert R. Renner who died intestate on August 28, 1968, reference Apartment 1056, File 4, Probate Court records. The children, Ivan Renner, Virginia R. Welsh, Ruth R. Fowler and Martha R. Lawless conveyed their interest to Deneer M. Renner by deed recorded in Deed Book 854, at page 175, on October 16, 1968.
