Words Used In This Document

- (A) Mortgage—This document, which is dated JULY 25, 1984 will be called the "Mortgage".
- (B) Borrower—MARY JANE HAGAN will be called "Borrower" and refers to the person(s) who signed the Note.
- (C) Mortgagor—PHYLLIS MARY R. HAGAN will sometimes be called "Mortgagor" and sometimes simply "I", "Me", "my", "mine", "myself", and "us" refer to the Mortgagor.
- (D) Lender—The South Carolina National Bank will be called "Lender" and sometimes simply "you", "Your" and "yours" refer to Lender. Lender is a national banking association which was formed and which exists under the laws of the United States of America.

Lender's address is Post Office Box 969, Greenville, SC 29602

- (E) Note—The note, note agreement, or loan agreement signed by Borrower and dated July 25, 1984, will be called the "Note". The Note shows that the Borrower has promised to pay Lender

If this box is checked, finance charges or interest under the Note will be deferred, accrued, or capitalized.

- (F) Property—The property that is described below in the section entitled "Description Of The Property" will be called the "Property".

My Transfer To You Of Rights In The Property

On this date, because you loaned the Borrower the money for which the Borrower gave you the Note, I mortgage, grant and convey the Property to you, your successors and assigns, subject to the terms of this Mortgage. This means that by signing this Mortgage, I am giving you those rights that are stated in this Mortgage and also those rights that the law gives to lenders who hold mortgages on real property. I am giving you these rights to protect you from possible losses that might result if:

- (A) the Borrower fails to pay all the amounts that the Borrower owes you as stated in the Note and any future advances made under Paragraph 17 of this Mortgage.
- (B) the Borrower fails to keep all of the other promises and agreements under the Note.
- (C) I fail to keep the promises and agreements which I make in this Mortgage.

This Mortgage secures any renewals, extensions, and/or modifications of the Note.

Description Of The Property

- (A) The Property which I mortgage, grant, and convey to you, your successors and assigns, is located in

Greenville County and has the following legal description:
All that lot of land in the county of Greenville, state of South Carolina, in O'Neal Township, in school district 356, containing 4.36 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of Gary and Connie Styles, made by Terry T. Dill, Eng., dated September 28, 1973 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-E at Page 133, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Langley Road, at the corner of Balding, and running thence N. 01-31 E. 674 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 52-51 E. 399 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 00-40 W. 354 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 49-25 W. 112.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 06-52 W. 435 feet to an iron pin in the center of said road; thence along the center of Langley Road, S. 73-50 W. 200 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to Percy Hagan by deed of Mary Jane H. Bishop recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 1130 at Page 843. Percy Hagan died testate on August 28, 1981 and according to record of his estate filed in Apartment 1669, File 23, in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, devised is entire estate to his widow, Phyllis Mary R. Hagan.

This mortgage is given as a correction of Mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 1674 at Page 331 because the wrong form was used.

The Property also includes the following:

- (B) All buildings and other improvements that are located on the property described in paragraph (A) of this section;
- (C) All rights in other property I have as owner of the property described in paragraph (A) of this section. These rights are known as "easements, rights and appurtenances attached to the property";
- (D) All rents or royalties from the property described in paragraph (A) of this section;
- (E) All mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights and water stock that are part of the property described in paragraph (A) of this section;
- (F) All rights that I have in the land which lies in the streets or roads in front of, or next to, the property described in paragraph (A) of this section;
