BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Walnut Lane at joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3, thence along the rear line of Lots 1 and 2, N. 86-45 E. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 3-15 E. 175 feet to an iron pin near the edge of the right-of-way of the Little Texas Poad (S. C. Highway No. 253); thence S. 60-03 W. 100.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence S. 65-14 W. 97 feet to an iron pin on the Ease side of Walnut Lane; thence with the East side of said Lane as the line, N. 3-15 W. 256 feet to the point of beginning.

ALSO all of the right, title and interest of the Grantor in and to that certain strip of land 37.5 feet, more or less, in width and 197.9 feet in length lying between the front line of Lots 1 and 2 and the center of the paved section of Little Texas Road (S. C. Highway No. 253), as shown more fully on said plat above referred to.
