- 2. Maximum and Minimum Monthly Payment
  Subject only the limitation on negative amortization provided in
  Paragraphs 3(B) and 4(D) of the Note, my principal and interest
  payment will not be increased or decreased on any Payment Change
  Date by more than twenty percent (20%) of the amount I have been
  paying. Should my loan balance exceed said limitation, the provisions of Paragraphs 3(B) and 4(D) of the Note shall apply.
- 3. Effectiveness of Provisions

  Except as otherwise provided in this Rider, all of the provisions of the Mortgage and Note shall remain in full force and effect.
