his heirs, successors and assigns, all her interest and estate, and also her right and claim of Dower of, in or to all and singular the Premises within mentioned and released.

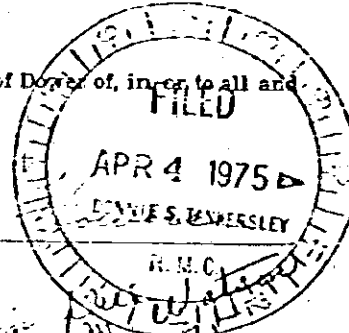
