I.

I hereby direct my Executrix, hereinafter named, to pay all my just debts, taxes and funeral expenses as soon as possible after my death.

II.

* I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of whatsoever nature and wheresoever situate, unto my wife, Silda H. Alexander, to be hers absolutely and in fee simple.

Should my wife predecease me, then, and in that event, I hereby give, devise and bequeath all of my said property in equal shares unto my brothers and sisters, my above mentioned wife's brothers and sisters and my above mentioned wife's parents, to be theirs absolutely, share and share alike.

IV.

I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my wife, Silda H. Alexander, as Executrix of this my last will and testament, to serve without bond, giving her full power and authority to sell, mortgage or dispose of any of my estate at any time in order to facilitate to carry out the terms of this my last will and testament.
