Place, the Machine Gun School, in Block 6, east of the 322nd Infantry.

The detail from each regiment will be formed and marched to the school by the senior noncommissioned officer, who will supply the senior instructor with a complete roster of the detail, signed by the company commander of the Machine Gun Company.
