KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Elean A. Walker  
& Mrs M. M. Tindall for valuable considerations unto  
us moving, and in consideration of the fact that the City of  
Greenville agrees to connect the sewer upon our premises with  
the sewer to be laid in the alley hereinafter mentioned, we  
the said Elean A. Walker, & Mrs M. M. Tindall  
hereby grant unto the said City of Greenville an easement in  
the alley running through our property on Rutherford Street  
and being 5 feet wide, for the purpose of laying its  
sewer system in the said alley, and for the purpose of main-  
taining the said system at the said place, giving unto it the  
right to do all necessary excavations for such purposes and the  
right of ingress and egress at all times. And we do hereby  
bind ourselves, our executors, administrators, and assigns  
to protect the said City of Greenville in the enjoyment of the  
said easement as against us, our heirs, executors, administra-  
tors, and all other persons whomsoever.
