Greenville Man Sentenced for Sex Crimes on Child

Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor Walt Wilkins states that STEVEN DOUGLAS DAVIS, age 46, pled guilty on June 16, 2011, and was sentenced by the Honorable Letitia Verdin on the offenses of Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor First Degree, Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor Second Degree, and Lew Act on a Child. STEVEN DOUGLAS DAVIS was sentenced to 20 years in the South Carolina Department of Corrections. STEVEN DOUGLAS DAVIS will have to serve at least 85 percent of the 20 year sentence before he becomes eligible for parole.

Evidence presented at the plea hearing by assistant solicitor Bryna Seay established that between 1980 and 1985 STEVEN DOUGLAS DAVIS repeatedly sexually abused a younger relative in Greenville County. The case was investigated by Investigator Heather Hubert of the Greenville County Sheriff's Office.
