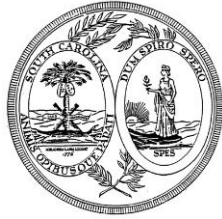

SOLICITOR ANNOUNCES WINNERS IN “**SAY

The grand prize is \$300 and the winning entry will be on the cover of the calendar. The three second place winners each received \$200. Each of the nine third place winners received \$100. The winning students, their parents, art teachers and principals as well as the contest judges were invited to the courtroom presentation.

“I am pleased to continue the drug awareness calendar for the twenty fourth year,” said Solicitor Wilkins. “It is a positive way to use seized assets of illegal drug dealers to both educate our children about the dangers of drug use and to recognize those who use their talents in a productive way.”
