IN THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Currently, a Fifty-five (\$55.00) Dollar fee is required to file a civil action in the Court of Common Pleas. Specific statutory exceptions exist waiving the fee in certain proceedings.

They are:

1. Post Conviction Relief actions, if accompanied by a properly signed and notarized Affidavit of Indigency. See §17-27-60, S.C. Code of Laws and Rule 50, Supreme Court of South Carolina.
2. Employment Security Commission proceedings involving a claim for benefits. See §14-39-30, S. C. Code of Laws.

The Clerk of Court must collect the filing fee to initiate any other civil action in the Court of Common Pleas.

This Order shall remain in effect until changed by Administrative Order of this Court or by Order of the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of South Carolina.

This Order has been approved by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of South Carolina.
