

In 2000, the Chief Judge for Administrative Purposes for this Circuit assigned all taxpayer lawsuits filed by Mr. Sloan to the Honorable John C. Few. This Order reaffirms that assignment. The Clerk shall direct all lawsuits filed by Mr. Sloan to the office of Judge Few, who shall coordinate the timely disposition of those cases.

In order to assist Judge Few in the timely disposition of these cases, the Court hereby directs Mr. Sloan to provide Judge Few, through his counsel, a monthly update of all cases pending before this Court, including the status of any pending motions or other matters. The update should include the proposed trial date for the case, and should be set forth in roughly the form that Mr. Sloan's counsel Jim Carpenter has been using in letters sent to Judge Few at Judge Few's request over the last four years. Any additional information that might be helpful to the Court in the timely disposition of these cases may also be included.
