
Standing Administrative Order

Guardian ad Litem on Civil Actions


The court finds that it is in the interest of justice that all routine Orders of Reference in foreclosure and partition actions should be signed by the Clerk of Court as permitted by Rule 53, SCRCP, rather than the chief administrative judge for Common Pleas. The Clerk is authorized to coordinate with the office of the Master-in-Equity to implement this Order, which is designed to expedite these actions and further judicial economy.

The Clerk of Court is also authorized to sign routine Appointment of Guardian ad Litem as allowed by Rule 17(d)(1).


