

# Development of the W. Walt Wilkins 2022 Anti-Drug Calendar



#### Warning Signs:

#### How can you tell if your child is abusing drugs or alcohol?

There is no single telltale pattern, experts say - especially since the teenage years often produce unpredictable behavior changes. There are, however, some tip-offs that your child may be struggling, including:

- Chronic eye redness, sore throat and/or dry cough.
- Chronic lying or unusual secrecy.
- Trouble in school or with the law, such as stealing.
- Deteriorating relationships with family and friends.
- Wild mood swings, hostility or abusive behavior.
- Chronic fatigue, withdrawal, carelessness about personal hygiene.
- Major changes in eating or sleeping patterns.
- Changes in grades, including increased grades due to misuse of stimulants.

#### A Message From Just Say Something:

Dear Parents,

Red Ribbon Week is the perfect opportunity for parents and grandparents to start and continue important conversations about drugs and alcohol that will lead to healthier choices and stronger connections with their children. Research proves that parents have the greatest influence on their children's decision about using drugs and we have the most influence in the early years. Time is precious to everyone and it is the most valuable resource we can share with our children. Teachable moments occur every day and parents should see these as the opportunity to talk to their children about tough subjects such as drugs, alcohol, and other challenges they will face. What you say doesn't have to be perfect; it just has to be honest, from the heart, and in their best interest.

Now, during this pandemic is a perfect time to talk about the anxiety and fear they may be experiencing and the role they play in our lives at any age. For some, it is a time when they will make poor and unhealthy decisions to seek relief or escape from those feelings. There is another epidemic taking place and it is a drug epidemic. You have so many opportunities to establish a great communication connection with your children right now as it relates to being healthy and keeping their bodies and brains clear and protected against all kinds of threats and epidemics. You should know everything there is to know about your child -- their likes and dislikes, their favorite subject(s), what they like to do for fun, who their friends are, and their friends' parents, etc. Parents and grandparents are in the unique position of spending time every day with their children so they have the ability to have ongoing conversations about the dangers of substance use and other risky behaviors. So while you are spending time together staying safe, the timing is perfect to talk with them in order to protect your child and help them live life to the fullest and free of substance use and addiction.
