## Join our fantastic team at GCEMS!

Greenville County Emergency Medical Services (GCEMS) has partnered with S.C. Works and Greenville Technical College to create the GCEMS Academy which incorporates first-hand real work exposure as an employee of GCEMS and the County of Greenville.

This 10-week all expenses paid program is designed to train the future workforce of GCEMS. Greenville Technical College (GTC) will deliver the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) training in combination with GCEMS. SC Works will help students with the enrollment process and will pay for all training costs\*, and GCEMS will provide job offers to all individuals who successfully complete the program.

#### About the GCEMS Academy

- Classes are scheduled for a total of 40 hours per week:
  - 20 hours/week of lecture through GTC
  - 20 hours/week of work experience training (Labs) within the GCEMS Department.
- Prepares students to take the exam to become a certified EMT *plus* earn a GTC academic certificate
- Graduates will receive job offers from GCEMS, one of the leading EMS departments in the nation. Job candidates must be willing to commit to a two-year assignment at GCEMS.

SC Works will facilitate enrollment for all GCEMS Academy students, in partnership with Greenville Technical College. SC Works will pay all costs, including tuition, fees, books, supplies, costs for certifications and other related exams or tests. Students may also qualify to receive an hourly stipend of \$12 for participating in the work experience training assignments (Labs) within the GCEMS Department.

GCEMS' mission is to provide a service that strives for excellence in prehospital care through service, innovation, and leadership. The department offers competitive

starting pay (\$15.61/hr.), 11 paid holidays, sick leave, annual leave, Group Health and Dental Insurance, State Retirement, 401K, onsite Education Department, and paid Continuing Education Program (CEP) and Provider Courses (BLS, CPR).
