

AN ORDINANCE

TO PROVIDE FOR THE MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED BY THE CANEBRAKE FIRE SERVICE AREA.

WHEREAS, the Canebrake Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control has presented a budget and millage request to Greenville County Council providing for expenditures of revenues acquired by the Canebrake Fire Service Area pursuant to ad valorem property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Canebrake Fire Service Area is authorized by Ordinance No. 1325, as amended, to annually levy ad valorem property tax millage for operations and maintenance, and the Board of Fire Control has requested an increase to the Fire Service Area’s current millage rate for maintenance of a reserve account.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Millage Rate and Tax Levy. Greenville County Council approves the continuation of the current total millage of twenty-five (25.0) mills (consisting of twenty and one-tenth (20.1) mills for operations and maintenance and four and nine-tenths (4.9) mills for a reserve) for the Canebrake Fire Service Area. Furthermore, County Council approves an additional levy of twelve (12.0) mills for the maintenance of a reserve account pursuant to S.C. Code § 6-1-320(D), as requested by the Canebrake Fire Service Area Board of Fire Control for a total increase in millage from 25 to 37 mills.

The Auditor and Tax Collector of Greenville County are hereby directed to levy and collect the millage rates authorized by this Ordinance.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
