**WHEREAS**, the Spring Park Inn is locally significant to the history and development of Travelers Rest as a place of respite from 1852 to 1941; and

**WHEREAS**, the Spring Park Inn began as an outpost on one of the major transportation routes over the mountains and into North Carolina; and

**WHEREAS**, the home became the basis for the development of the town of Travelers Rest and served as a primary hub for the community in the early twentieth century; and

WHEREAS, the Spring Park Inn is on the National Historic Register; and

**WHEREAS**, at its meeting held on January 17, 2019, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission voted to recommend that the Spring Park Inn be added to the Greenville County Historic Register; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenville County Historic Preservation Commission may commemorate this designation by affixing a plaque the structure noting its placement on the Greenville County Historic Register;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Greenville County Council hereby approves placing the Spring Park Inn on the Greenville County Historic Register.
