A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD DURING THE LIVE-STREAMED GREENVILLE COUNTY REGULAR MEETING ON TUESDAY, JULY 21, 2020, AT 4:00 p.m. (or at such time thereafter as the hearing may be held), FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECEIVING PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING THE MILLAGE REQUEST BY THE BOILING SPRINGS DISTRICT FOR THE FY2021 TAX YEAR.

THE BOILING SPRINGS BOARD OF FIRE CONTROL, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF S.C. CODE ANN. SECTION 6-11-275, AS AMENDED, HAS REQUESTED GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL INCREASE THE AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX INCREASE OF THE BOILING SPRINGS FIRE DISTRICT BY TWO (2.0) MILLS, BRINGING THE TOTAL MILLAGE FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE TO TWENTY-NINE AND FOUR-TENTHS (29.4) MILLS, WHICH CONSISTS OF OPERATING MILLAGE ALLOWABLE (CPI AND POPULATION GROWTH) FOR FY2020-2021 PURSUANT TO S.C. CODE § 6-1-320(A)(1) AND OPERATING MILLAGE ALLOWED BUT NOT IMPOSED FOR THE PRECEDING PROPERTY TAX YEAR PURSUANT TO S.C. CODE § 6-1-320(A)(2).
