Dear Ms. Wood:

If not for a prior commitment at an out of state meeting, I would be present at your Public Safety and Human Services Committee September 14<sup>th</sup> interview. I would very much like to assist in improving our wastewater collection system.

I would not be starting from scratch with Metro Connects (Metro). I've known Jim Freeland, Caleb Freeman, Carol Elliott, Jason Bagwell, and Christie Whitmire for over twenty years and have worked with them all. I also previously worked with Mike Dickson. When I had my small engineering company, we owned and/or operated several pump stations and several gravity lines/force mains, some that discharged into Metro. Overall, I owned and/or operated almost 40 pump stations and over 40 miles of gravity and force-main sewer lines for over a decade. My company owned a jetvac truck, CCTV truck, two crane trucks, and a smoke machine. Among other things, we performed inspections, maintenance of manholes, lines, pump stations, and right of ways. As an engineer, I've performed work for over a half-dozen different public sewer utilities, including flow measurement and SCADA management. I learned a lot from that work and understand the difficulties and costs of sewer maintenance and repair. I closed my engineering business in 2014 to simply my business back to mainly law.

While at the University of South Carolina, I taught courses on wastewater collection and treatment, water quality, risk assessment, and environmental law. As an Adj. Professor at Clemson, I've given lectures on wastewater, water quality, solid and hazardous waste management, and environmental law.

As an attorney, I've represented several public sewer utilities. In the early 2000s, I represented Taylors Fire and Sewer District in a lawsuit against ReWa regarding I/I and associated ReWa requirements. ReWa has changed significantly since then, in good way. I know and respect Graham Rich and have performed work for ReWa. ReWa is not currently a client nor are any other public sewer utilities. I do currently work for Greenville County and several other counties, municipalities, and SCDOT in stormwater matters relating to their Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permits.
