AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND SECTION 24 OF CHAPTER 8, ARTICLE II OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA ENTITLED "FLOOD CONTROL, DRAINAGE, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT - FLOODS AND FLOOD CONTROL" SO AS TO LIMIT THE ORDINANCE'S APPLICATION TO CERTAIN PARCELS ADJACENT TO AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD

BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Amendment.</u> Section 24 of Chapter 8, Article II of the Code of Ordinances of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Greenville County Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, is hereby amended as follows:

"I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Section 8-24. - Lands to Which this Ordinance Applies.

This ordinance shall apply to all parcels of land that lie either wholly or partially within, or immediately adjacent to, areas of special flood hazard, and certain parcels of land immediately adjacent to areas of special flood hazard, as specifically identified in this ordinance, that are within the jurisdiction of the unincorporated areas of Greenville County, South Carolina. These areas of special flood hazard identified by the Department of Homeland Security-FEMA, National Flood Insurance Program, in its Flood Insurance Study, dated May 4, 2021 with accompanying maps and other supporting data are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of this ordinance. Further, this ordinance shall apply to any areas of special flood hazard established and accepted by Greenville County that utilize DHS-FEMA NFIP detailed flood study standards, or better."

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
