Please accept the enclosed donation of \$500,000 designated for construction of the ~2-mile Travelers Rest Greenway trail on easements secured by UGATA. We have appreciated the opportunity to partner with Greenville County in the design and permitting of this trail, and look forward to seeing this trail built on the easements we have acquired. As we have discussed, our understanding is that with these funds, together with other Greenville County funds, Greenville County will be able to award a contract to complete construction of the trail substantially per the plans in the construction bid package released on October 20, 2023 with the concrete pavement option.
