A RESOLUTION

TO AMEND SECTIONS (A) AND (C) OF RESOLUTION No. 1947 ESTABLISHING THE GREENVILLE COUNTY CITIZEN'S ACADEMY TO UPDATE THE ACADEMY'S APPOINTMENT AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Amendment to Greenville County Citizen's Academy Resolution</u> <u>Section (A)</u>. Section (A) of Resolution 1947 creating a Greenville Citizen's Academy is hereby amended as follows:

(A) A Greenville County Citizen's Academy is hereby established which shall be comprised of twenty-four (24) members, appointed by County Council. Each member of County Council will nominate two residents from <u>the County Council member'stheir</u> respective Council District for appointment by County Council. Prospective appointees must be a registered voter in Greenville County and must complete an application form. Appointees cannot be elected officials or an employee of Greenville County or any municipality. The Academy will run from January until November. Each November, a new class will be appointed by Council. If the class size is less than twenty-four (24) members, then the remaining spaces will be open for appointees from any Council District.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Amendment to Greenville County Citizen's Academy Resolution</u> <u>Section (C)</u>. Section (C) of Resolution 1947 creating a Greenville Citizen's Academy is hereby amended so as to delete Section (C).

(C) The Academy will meet once a month, except for July, from January until November from 9am until approximately 3pm.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective on the date of its adoption.
