

AN ORDINANCE

TO REPEAL GREENVILLE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 4086 (“AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENVILLE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 3203 SO AS TO FURTHER DEFINE THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE APPOINTED COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION, AND TO INTEGRATE THE PLANNING STAFF WITH OTHER COUNTY GOVERNMENT FUNCTIONS”) AND TO RESTORE PRIOR PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Greenville County, South Carolina:

Section 1. Repeal Greenville County Ordinance No. 4086.

Greenville County Ordinance No. 4086 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Restoration of Prior Provisions. The provisions of Greenville County Ordinance No. 3203, “An Ordinance to Amend Act Number 129 of the Acts of 1963, as Amended, which Act Created the Greenville County Planning Commission, so as to have Greenville County Council Re-Establish the Greenville County Planning Commission so as to Bring the Greenville County Planning Commission into Compliance with the Comprehensive Planning Act of 1994,” as they existed immediately prior to the adoption of Ordinance No. 4086 are revived and reinstated to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Section 3. Application. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply prospectively only, beginning on the date of approval of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Repeal of Inconsistent Provisions. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on the date of its adoption.
