CONSTITUTION WEEK

WHEREAS, September 17, 2025 marks the 238th anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America, designating September 17–23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS, it is a privilege and duty of the American people to commemorate the 238th anniversary with patriotic ceremonies and activities; and

WHEREAS, this historic milestone in American history allows us to reflect back on our nation's past, and consider the sacrifice and determination our forefathers had to bring us to this day; and

WHEREAS, we honor the contributions of our nation's architects, by looking to our future, encouraging this and future generations to keep the faith and to protect and defend this magnificent document.

NOW, THEREFORE, Greenville County Council does honor and recognize our great American heritage and encourage all citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by protecting those freedoms that are guaranteed to us through this document; and do hereby proclaim September 14 - 20, 2025 as
