

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 5577, WHICH UPDATED DESIGN STANDARDS FOR SEPTIC DEVELOPMENTS IN THE UNZONED AREAS OF THE COUNTY AND ESTABLISHED COUNTYWIDE RIPARIAN BUFFER REQUIREMENTS, TO CHANGE THE SUNSET PROVISION FOR THE ORDINANCE FROM JANUARY 2, 2026 TO JANUARY 2, 2028.

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council enacted Ordinance No. 5577 on January 2, 2024, to regulate the design standards for septic developments in the unzoned areas of the County and to establish a countywide riparian buffer; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 5577 states the provisions and requirements of the Ordinance will expire two years from its effective date unless the Ordinance was re-adopted by Greenville County Council; and

WHEREAS, Greenville County Council would like to extend the date of the sunset provision to January 2, 2028, which will allow more time for Council to study the effects of the regulations before the Ordinance is either re-adopted or expires.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the County Council of Greenville County, South Carolina:

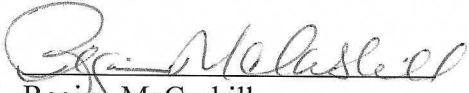
Section 1. Amendment to the Sunset Provision of Ordinance No. 5577.

The provisions and requirements of this Ordinance shall expire on January 2, 2028 unless re-adopted by Greenville County Council.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.

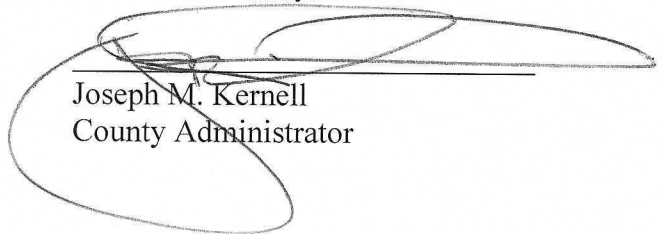
