

AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND AN AGREEMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A JOINT COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AND BUSINESS PARK OF LAURENS AND GREENVILLE COUNTIES SO AS TO ENLARGE THE PARK. (*Project Hunter*)

WHEREAS, Laurens County and Greenville County entered into an agreement for development of a joint county industrial park dated as of April 13, 2026 (the “Park Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Park Agreement, the boundaries of the park created therein (the “Park”) may be enlarged pursuant to ordinances of the respective County Councils of Laurens County and Greenville County; and

WHEREAS, in connection with certain incentives being offered by Laurens County, it is now desired that the boundaries of the Park be enlarged to include certain tracts of real estate described in the schedule attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A (as such description may be hereafter refined) (“Property”); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Greenville County Council be it ordained by Greenville County Council that the Park is hereby and shall be amended and revised to include the Property located in Laurens County described in the schedule attached to this Ordinance, and, due to the adoption by Laurens County Council of a corresponding ordinance as of June 8, 2026, the Park Agreement shall be deemed amended to so include such Property.
