Dear JOE KERNELL

The South Carolina Department of Public Health ("DPH") distributes state appropriated EMS funds in accordance with Section 31.7 of the Part IB Provisos of the 2025-2026 Appropriations Act. The funds must be utilized as outlined in this document and for the purpose of improving and upgrading the Emergency Medical Services system throughout the state. The monies allocated to the Counties are for the purpose of improving or upgrading the local EMS system through the licensed ambulance services. The funds are allocated in accordance with the following methodology or formula: 50% of the funds appropriated will be allocated equally among the 46 counties in SC and the remaining 50% will be allocated based on the proportion of the population in each county.

GREENVILLE County's allocation for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 is determined to be \$33,198.36

Disbursement of these funds will take place once we receive the signed agreement. No funds shall be disbursed to organizations or purposes which practice discrimination against persons by virtue of race, creed,color,or national origin.

In addition to these requirements, Proviso 31.7 allows local matching funds to be provided by the recipients of the allocations. In order to meet these requirements, you will need to ensure that the receiving party meets the 5.5% matching amount and a description of the local matching fund.

DPH has multiple EMS/Trauma distribution invoices that are due to the regions, counties, and trauma centers. Every year, these entities receive funds from the Legislature through two provisos, 31.7 (Emergency Medical Services) & 31.21 (South Carolina State Trauma Care Fund), and some quarter percent funding from insurance. These funds are required to run the four Regional EMS offices that perform most of the EMS training in the State as well as provide counties with funds for improving and upgrading the EMS system through licensed ambulance services. Some of these entities and councils are having to dip into their contingency funds to operate. DPH must release these funds quickly so they can continue to train EMS personnel. Their work is vital to the citizens of South Carolina.

We respectfully ask that you process these as z-special so that we can release payment to the vendors immediately after the processed distribution invoices are audited and approved by State CGO.
