3. Greenville County collects used oil at all six of our Residential Waste and Recycling Centers in addition to the Twin Chimneys Landfill. SC Waste Management collects and processes what is collected at each center. (see attachment for site listings). All seven sites collect oil under carports or awnings and all tanks either on concrete or asphalt.
4. Greenville County will promote used oil and filter recycling through brochures, the County website, and banners placed at all Residential Waste and Recycling Centers and the Twin Chimneys Landfill. The importance of oil recycling will also be highlighted during tours and presentations given by the division.
 - a. Greenville County would like to add banner brackets to our new mixed paper compactors that will allow interchangeable promotional banners that will effectively become “Mobile Billboards” many will promote used oil and filter recycling.
 - b. Based on the population of Greenville County (500,000+), we are requesting \$4,000 for public education.

5. Greenville County would like to purchase the following items to help support our waste oil collection.

a. Greenville County prefers to keep an extra waste oil collection tank secondary containment pan in storage at all times. In the event one of our locations has damage we can quickly replace it. This year we deployed our spare so we would like to replace it. It will be stored at the Twin Chimney Landfill until it is needed at any one of our seven waste oil collection facilities.

Greenville County operates seven oil collection facilities for residents to use. To ensure environmental compliance, we are requesting the following items to prevent and or clean up spills at all seven of our locations.

- 14 Oil spill kits (\$1,076.00 total)
- 210 3'x12' absorbent sock (\$2,248.00 total)
- 32 5'x10' absorbent booms (\$976.00 total)
- 500 Heavyweight absorbent mat pads (\$645.00 total)
- 10 Ultratech filter sock (\$1,320.00 total)
- 120 3'x42" absorbent sock (\$324.00 total)
- 120 3'x4' absorbent sock (474.00 total)

Total cost for equipment and supplies: \$8,776.00 Including tax and shipping.

b. Greenville County uses SC Waste Management for collect and processing all used oil and filters from our facilities. SC Waste Management does not charge for pickup or processing so we are requesting **\$0** for contract services.
