SUBJECT: Road Paving List (FY 2027)

Please find attached the proposed paving list for your district for the 2027 paving season. Staff has field reviewed all of the roads on the list. Attached you will find a list and USB drive with pictures of each of the roads in your district on the list for you to review and inspect.

The roads on your lists have been chosen based primarily on their PCI (Pavement Condition Index) rating (1-100) as well as their location within the County. Every four years a firm is hired to ride every county road and evaluate it using advanced scanning equipment to determine the condition of each road. They then study the data and apply a PCI rating from 1 to 100 for each road. The latest study was performed in 2024.

While individual PCI is the driving factor for road selection, staff also considers the aggregate PCI of subdivisions and neighborhoods/areas. This is done to decrease contractor mobilization costs and increase resident satisfaction, making paving more efficient and cost effective.

The overall road list will be voted on at the Roads, Infrastructure & Public Works Committee (RIPW) meeting on August 18, 2026 and then forwarded to County Council for approval.
