

RENTAL & UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)

Utilizing Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 funds, Greenville County is administering the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP). This federally funded program provides residential rent and utility assistance for eligible residents of Greenville County.

ELIGIBILITY

An eligible household is defined as a renter household in which at least one or more individuals meets **ALL** of the following criteria:

- Qualifies for unemployment due to COVID-19, has experienced a reduction in household income due to COVID-19, or has incurred significant costs due to COVID-19 or experienced a financial hardship due to COVID-19.
- Demonstrates a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability (including eviction notice, utility shutoff notice, past due rent notice, past due utility notice, or any other evidence of unsafe or unhealthy living conditions or housing stability).
- Has a household income at or below 80 percent of the area median income.
