## **GCLDD Structural Fill Procedure**

"Structural fill" means land filling for future beneficial use utilizing land-clearing debris, hardened concrete, hardened/cured asphalt, bricks, blocks, and other materials specified by SCDHEC by regulation, compacted and landfilled in a manner acceptable to SCDHEC, consistent with applicable engineering, and construction standards and carried out as a part of normal activities associated with construction, demolition, and land-clearing operations; however, the materials utilized must not have been contaminated by hazardous constituents, petroleum products, or painted with lead-based paint.

## Structural fill may not provide a sound structural base for building purposes.

- 1. All owners which plan to place structural fill material on a parcel will be required to meet all SCDHEC requirements for structural fill.
- 2. Any owner who places structural fill material on a parcel without a permit from SCDHEC will be required to permit the fill through SCDHEC after-the-fact or obtain a letter from SCDHEC allowing the fill to remain.
- 3. Once a permit has been granted by SCDHEC a Greenville County Land Disturbance Permit must be obtained for the land grading associated with the fill.
- Once a project is complete the property owner will complete all close out requirements of SCDHEC which includes recording of a plat showing the location of the structural fill.
- 5. Owner will close Greenville County grading permit after closing the SCDHEC Structural Fill Permit.
- 6. The following documents will be provided as closure of the County Grading Permit:
  - Copy of SCDHEC closure documents
  - Copy of recorded plat
  - Maintenance Agreements
  - As-built survey and letter of certification for all site water quality and quantity features and BMP's
  - Point of contact information for owner
  - Acknowledgement note that any further development, grading and/or land form change requires appropriate County Land Development permit
- 7. An administrative hold will be placed on the building permit for the tax map number of the platted structural fill parcel until all appropriate development permits are obtained.
