

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF ACT 833 OF THE 1970 ACTS AND JOINT RESOLUTIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF SOUTH CAROLINA WHICH REQUIRES THE GREENVILLE COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION TO HAVE AN ANNUAL AUDIT OF ITS AFFAIRS PREPARED BY A CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANT

BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Authority. This ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority conferred upon Greenville County by Subsection 3 of Act No. 283 (1975 SC Acts 692, 716-717 commonly referred to as The Home Rule Act), and §4-9-30 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1976), as amended.

Section 2. Amendment. Section 6 of Act No. 833 of the 1970 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of South Carolina is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Fiscal year and audit.--The Commission shall conduct its affairs on the fiscal year basis employed by Greenville County. As shortly after the close of its fiscal year as may be practicable, an audit report of its affairs shall be made by the Commission to the Greenville County Council. Copies of such audit, incorporated into an annual report of the Commission, shall be filed with the Clerk of the Greenville County Council and in the office of the clerk of court for the county."

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon the date of its adoption and shall apply to fiscal year 1993.
