

AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 784 SO AS TO DELETE THE GREENVILLE COUNTY MUSEUM COMMISSION AND TO REORGANIZE AND RESTRUCTURE THE GREENVILLE COUNTY MUSEUM COMMISSION AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND TERMS OF ITS COMMISSION MEMBERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. The Greenville County Museum Commission is hereby deleted from Ordinance No. 784.

Section 2. The Greenville County Museum Commission shall consist of seven (7) members. The Greenville County Council shall appoint the seven (7) members and of those initially appointed, three shall serve a one-year term, two shall serve two-year terms, and two shall serve three-year terms as designated by Greenville County Council. All future appointments shall be made by the Greenville County Council. Recommendations may be received from the Greenville County Art Association, Inc. A member shall be eligible for reappointment to only one additional three-year term. However, an individual appointed to a term of less than two years shall be eligible for reappointment to two, subsequent three-year terms. All members shall be residents of Greenville County. One of the criteria to be considered in appointing members shall be the knowledge or interest in the arts. An effort should be made to assure that various geographic areas of the county are represented.

Section 3. All terms of the present members of the Museum Commission shall expire on the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. The Museum Commission shall make periodic reports, no less frequently than once a year, to the Greenville County Council, summarizing its activities and showing its financial status.

corporate the above changes. Except as herein amended, said Act shall remain in full force and effect as an ordinance of Greenville County.

Section 7. This Ordinance is authorized by Section 3 of Act No. 283 of the 1975 Acts and Joint Resolutions of the General Assembly of the State of South Carolina.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
