

AN ORDINANCE

TO RECOGNIZE THE RENAMING OF THE DONALDSON CENTER INDUSTRIAL AIR PARK TO THE SOUTH CAROLINA TECHNOLOGY & AVIATION CENTER (SCTAC); TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 3068 TO REFLECT THE NAME CHANGE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Joint Resolution Nos. 76-3 and 93a by the City of Greenville and Greenville County respectively, the City and County purchased the Donaldson Air Force Base as joint owners in 1976, renaming Donaldson Air Force Base, the Donaldson Center Industrial Air Park;

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville and Greenville County, through the Donaldson Development Commission, have successfully operated the Donaldson Center Industrial Air Park for the economic benefit of the people of Greenville County;

WHEREAS, recognizing that renaming the Donaldson Center Industrial Air Park, the South Carolina Technology & Aviation Center (SCTAC), will allow the Center to capitalize on the Upstate's international reputation, while preserving the Center's historical legacy through the commemoration of Donaldson Field as the official name of the airport;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Recognize Renaming and Amend Ordinance to Reflect Renaming.
County Council hereby approves and recognizes that the Donaldson Center Industrial Air Park is renamed the South Carolina Technology & Aviation Center (SCTAC), and the Donaldson Development Commission is hereby known as the SCTAC Board of Directors. Ordinance No. 3068 is hereby amended to reflect the name change.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption.
