


What do I do when I've found a litter of kittens?



Is mom with them?

Get them spayed or neutered at 8 weeks old

Mom too! Contact the Animal Care clinic to make an appointment to have them spayed or neutered. If mom is not social, she can be spayed for free through the Community Cats program and returned to her original location.

Foster in Place

Contact Animal Care to get care instructions and foster supplies so you can care for them until they're 8 weeks old. If mom is there, place wet food and water out for her daily.

Help them find homes

Be on the search for friends, family, neighbors or coworkers who are looking to adopt a loving, fixed feline.
