

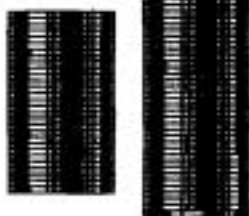


The Meadows of Cambell Creek Preliminary Plan

Project Description

The Meadows of Cambell Creek is a 150-acre development located in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina. The project consists of 10 tracts of land, each with its own acreage and contour interval. The tracts are numbered 1 through 10, with a total area of 154.81 acres. The development is situated on a hillside with a maximum elevation of 453 feet and a minimum elevation of 11.16 feet. The project is bounded by the Glassy Mountain Road to the north and the Cambell Creek to the south. The tracts are separated by roads and are surrounded by a mix of wooded and open areas. The project is a residential development and is subject to the zoning regulations of Glassy Mountain Township.
