Ladies and Gentlemen of the Planning Commission:

I am writing you folks to request a setback variance in order to build a house on my lot. The lot is unique in that it is long and narrow (shaped almost like a piece of pie). The septic system is located in the smallest end. I don't need a lot to meet the setbacks.

I have attached a plat with the septic system location and the proposed house location for your review. The proposed location does respect the overhead power lines right of way. There is at least 30' from the house to the neighboring property line. The back of the house comes up between six and ten feet short of the Hwy 414 setback of forty feet from the right of way. Even with this deficit, it is still some ninety feet from the center of the road. We have had a house designed to be long and narrow in an effort to meet the setbacks but have fallen a few feet short. I don't see us as being an issue with road or utility maintenance since the adjacent home is built on the right of way on both sidesthough it has been there for 70 years. Thanks for your time and consideration.
