Watkins who, being sworn, says that as attorney he is familiar with the transaction by which Judson Mills conveyed certain real estate to Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation by deed dated March 27, 1948; that said deed was delivered in connection with the dissolution of Judson Mills and was in effect the transfer of assets thereof to its stockholder, Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation; that in the transfer, Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation assumed liabilities of Judson Mills in the amount of \$4,010,850.00, receiving assets of Judson Mills valued at \$12,842,317.00; that of such assets, the amount of \$379,527.38 represented real property, such real property being 2.95% of the total property received by Cotwool Manufacturing Corporation; that 2.95% of the liabilities thus assumed amounts to \$118,520.00, and documentary stamps are affixed to the deed based upon this consideration being paid for the real property conveyed.
