In view of Assistant Attorney General, Joseph C. In view of the non-acquiescence of the South Carolina Tax Commission in the above-referred to Attorney General's opinion, I am writing to assure you that should it ultimately be decided that documentary stamps are required on leases for a term of years, we will pay for such stamps on the lease referred to above. In the meantime, I will attempt to resolve the difference of opinion between the office of the Attorney General and the Tax Commission.
