KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J.J. McSwain
City of Greenville in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of ^{five} Thirty-eight hundred and twenty (\$3825.00) Dollars,
to me

acknowledged, granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
A.G. New, all those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in
the County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, about two and one-half miles from the City
of Greenville, Tract No. 1, on the Old Rutherford Road, containing five and twenty
hundred (5252.00) acres, more or less and lying between the right of way of the Southern
Railway on the North and the Rutherford Road on the South, and F.C. Worleys land
on the East and the land of the Plowden Estate on the West.

Tract No. 2, also all that certain other piece, parcel or lot of land adjoining the above
tract, containing twenty-seven and one-fourth (27-1/4) acres, more or less:
Beginning at an iron pin on the North side of the right of way of the Southern Railway
Company remaining; thence N. 29 W. 10. chains to post-oak; thence N. 54-1/2 W. 16.70
chains to an iron pin; thence S. 34 W. 14.30 chains to a stone; thence S. 68 E. 26 chains
to an iron pin on the North side of the right of way of the Southern Railway Company;
