- other appliances, and to cut, quarry, dig and take away any stone, wood, gravel or earth necessary for the construction, operation and repair of said road or line, and to make all necessary cuts and fills, and to do any and all acts necessary or appropriate for any proper purpose connected with said road or line. And also the right, privilege and easement to construct and maintain upon, along and over said strip, belt or right of way, in a proper manner, with poles, towers, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances a line or lines for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, or for telegraph or telephone lines, or any or all of such uses, for railway and other commercial purposes.

To have and to hold all and singular the rights, privileges and easements as aforesaid in, to and upon said premises unto said grantee, its successors and assigns forever.
