Latimer in the County and State aforesaid, containing 208.75 acres, more or less, said lands as described in said deed being bounded by lands of Henry Smith, G.W. Sullivan, B.M. McGee, D.B. Jenkins, Reedy River. The said rights and privileges being those conveyed to us by deed from J.H. Latimer bearing date January 11, 1889, to which reference is made.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members and hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD ALL and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Fork Shoals Cotton Mill, its successors and assigns forever.
