Clyde, Trustee as aforesaid, pursuant to said resolution and order, and in consideration of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid, by the Home Building Association, at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Home Building Association, All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid, about one mile west of the City of Greenville and near the Monaghan Mills, in a sub-division of land known as "New Hope", on corner of Hoyt and Miller Streets, and designated as Lot No. 1 on a plat of said sub-division, which plat is recorded in the office of Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, in plat book A at page 307; being one of the lots conveyed to P.S. Butler by G.T. Gaines, by deed dated April 19th 1911, and recorded in said Register's office in Vol. 11 at page 392.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever of the said P.S. Butler, and all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, through or by him, freed from all liens and incumbrances.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Home Building Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of South Carolina, its successors and assigns forever.
