512 - said owner the peaceable possession of said premises; otherwise the said owner shall have the

right to eject said lessee from said premises as a tenant holding over after the expiration of

his lease and for non-payment of rent.

And it is further agreed that this contract shall extend to and bind the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.
