Warren Webster now desires to correct said error. Now therefore know all men by these presents; That I the said J. Warren Webster for and in the consideration of the premises and the sum of \$1.00 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, by the said A.C. Davis, (receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) do hereby agree that said typewritten slip attached to the original deed be and the same is hereby remover therefrom and discharged destroyed, and the said words "And avery other person whomsoever" which appear recorded in the general warranty clause of said deed, be erased of stricken out by the Register of Mesne Conveyance for said County, so that said deed will appear on the record as a quit claim deed, as intended. And I do hereby release and forever discharge the said A.C. Davis and her heirs, executors, administrators or assigns of and from all liability to defend any or all suits, claims and demands whatsoever that may be made or brought by any person whomsoever (other than herself and heirs) lawfully claiming said tract of land or any part thereof.
