demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 28th day of April 1910, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by J. W. Gray.

The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said William Scott, Robert Scott, Emma Butler and Richard Scott, that lot just beyond the western portion of the city of Greenville, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in what is known as Stranderville, beginning at an iron pin on Bob Alley at corner of lot 20, 3, owned by Anna Knowles, as shown by a plat recorded in Register of Mesne Conveyances Office, for Greenville County in Plat Book A., page 147, and running thence with Anna Knowles line 3.612, three hundred and forty-nine feet to an iron pin at line of W.S.
