is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

All my undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece
parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in Glassy Mountain
township, in the County and State aforesaid, containing one hundred and
eighty-six (186) acres, more or less, lying on top of Hoagback Mountain
and known as the Ramsey Butler Tract, being near the lands re-
cently sold by the heirs of the late L. N. Wilcox to R. E. Johnson, and
near lands of Joshua Lindsey, et al, having the following lines, metes
and bounds, to wit:—Beginning at a forked chestnut and run-
ning thence S. 55° W. 24.00 chains to a hickory; thence S. 15° W. 18.00
chains to a hickory; thence S. 16° W. 21.00 chains to a red oak;
thence S. 24° W. 3.50 chains to a hickory; thence S. 58° E. 4.00
chains to a red oak; thence N. 71° E. 13.00 chains to a chest-
nut; thence due east 16 chains to a red oak; thence N. 79° E.
20.00 chains to a spanish oak; thence N. 40° E. 7.00 chains to
a pine; thence N. 9° E. 23.00 chains to a spanish oak; thence
N. 56° W. 3.50 chains to a pine; thence S. 77° W. 9.00 chains
to a spanish oak; thence N. 15° W. 5.00 chains to a hickory;
thence N. 62° W. 14.00 chains to a forked chestnut at the
beginning of corner, this being the same tract of land
conveyed to H. M. Parris and J. R. Parris by the heirs
at law of the late L. H. Wilcox, deceased being the tract
of land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray, Master by his
