Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Gillette Gordon Harris

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Gillette Gordon Harris; - all that certain lot or parcel of land, together with all and singular the buildings and improvements thereon, situated, lying and being on the East side of Augusta Street, in the city of Greenville, Greenville County South Carolina, bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at an S.P. 3 X 16 8' South of the 3 X of Elkins Street, and running thence with Augusta Street, S. 0° - 30' E. 54' to an S.P. 3 X of Whitmire lot; thence east with said lot 100' to an S.P. thence N. 0° - 30' W. 53 feet to an S.P. 3 X; thence N. 89° 45' W. 100 feet to the beginning 3 X; Same being a portion of the real estate wherof the late Mrs. Fannie E. Harris died seized and possessed and which was conveyed by all the heirs at law of the said Mrs. Fannie E. Harris devised to the said Sallie Hart Harris, as their attorney-in-fact as aforesaid, with full power and authority to make conveyance thereof by good and sufficient deed - To which said power of attorney duly recorded in said Clerk's office reference is hereby made.
